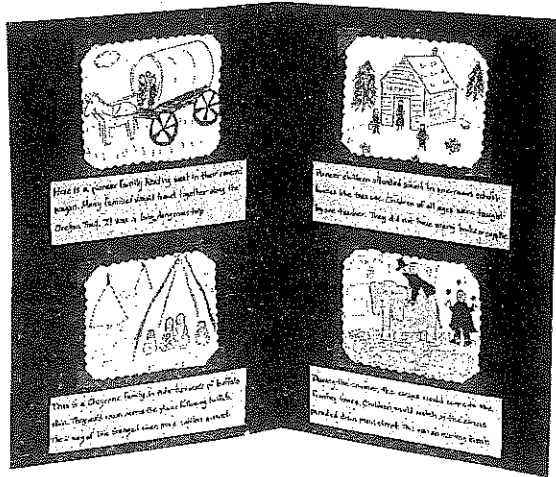
- Make a list of the most important people, places, events, and objects in the book. ^{+facts}
